SUMMARY

The Commonwealth Court of Pennsylvania was created by an amendment to the Pennsylvania Constitution in 1968. The court hears appeals from county courts of common pleas and state administrative agencies. From county courts, the Commonwealth Court hears appeals in matters involving zoning, taxation, civil service, negligence cases involving state and local government, and eminent domain, among others. From state administrative agencies, the court hears appeals in matters including workers' and unemployment compensation, environmental issues, welfare claims, and public utility rate disputes. In addition, the court acts as a trial court in certain types of cases where the Commonwealth is a party to the case.

In 2002, there were 4,785 new cases filed. This represents a 4% increase over the number of new cases filed in 2001.

New cases filed by inmates exploded in 2002. The number of new inmate cases in 2002 was 618. This represents an increase of 105% compared to the number of inmate cases filed in 2001.

In its appellate jurisdiction, workers' compensation and unemployment compensation appeals continued to be filed in large numbers. There were 796 new workers' compensation appeals filed in 2002, an increase of 2% over 2001. There were 454 unemployment compensation appeals filed in 2002, an increase of 41% over 2001. With respect to appeals from courts of common pleas, there was an 18% decrease in the number of new appeals filed. This was caused, in part, by a 41% decrease in motor vehicle license suspension appeals.

The court disposed of a total of 4,753 cases in 2002, an increase of 3% compared to 2001. There were 1,971 opinions filed in 2002, an increase of 2% compared with 2001. The average elapsed time from assignment of the case to the filing of the opinion was 97 days in 2002 compared to 102 days in 2001. The court disposed of 6,313 ancillary motions, applications and petitions in 2002, a 31% increase compared with 2001.

The court's mediation program continued to be successful in 2002. A total of 271 cases were referred to mediation, 248 were mediated, and 120 cases were settled, thus eliminating the need for further litigation.

Finally, this high level of productivity resulted in the fewest cases in inventory in the modern history of the court. There were 1,526 appeals pending at the end of 2002 compared to 2,790 appeals pending as recently as 1997. By way of further contrast, there were 3,439 pending appeals in 1988.
