York County Judicial Center Court Employee Tests Positive for COVID-19

HARRISBURG – York County Court Administration today announced that a judicial center court employee has tested positive for COVID-19.

The employee last worked in the judicial center on Friday, Aug. 21 and as required, adhered to health and safety guidelines including the use of personal protective equipment and social distancing when interacting with coworkers and the public.

Court administration has notified City of York public health officials, who will conduct contact tracing. Those potentially exposed, as defined by the Centers for Disease Control, will be notified by city public health officials. While contact tracing efforts have just started, at this time there is no indication the public was exposed to the affected employee.

Work areas with which the employee had physical contact have been cleaned.
