Honorable William F. Ward joined Rothman Gordon, P.C., after serving three years as a Judge on the Court of Common Pleas of Allegheny County, Pennsylvania. He previously served as: Chief of Staff to the Governor of Pennsylvania; First Deputy Attorney General of Pennsylvania; Chairman of the Pennsylvania Board of Probation and Parole; and Assistant United States Attorney for the Western District of Pennsylvania.

Bill currently serves as Chairman of the Accountability, Conduct and Ethics Commission of Allegheny County; Commissioner of the Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency (PCCD), and as Chairman of PCCD's Mental Health and Justice Advisory Committee. He is Chairman of the Board of the Autism Connection of Pennsylvania and is a Member of the Board of Trustees of ACHIEVA.
