MEMORANDUM OPINION  
BY JUDGE FIZZANO CANNON

FILED: April 8, 2022

Before the Court is the Petition to Set Aside Nominating Petition (Petition) of Mark Green and Charles M. Carn (Objectors) seeking to set aside the nominating petitions of Bernard Williams (Candidate) for the Democratic nomination for State Representative from the 190<sup>th</sup> Legislative District, which Objectors allege contain numerous invalid voter signatures.

To qualify for a major party ballot for Representative in the General Assembly, a prospective candidate must present a nominating petition containing at least 300 valid signatures of registered and enrolled members of the proper party. *See* 25 P.S. § 2872.1(14). The Court conducted a hearing on April 7, 2022, at which the parties stipulated that Candidate’s nominating petitions contained less than the

requisite 300 valid signatures to place Candidate on the ballot for May 17, 2022 primary election.<sup>1</sup>

For these reasons, we grant the Petition.
