- Governor William Findlay appointed Huston, President Judge, 4th Judicial District (Bedford, Huntington, Mifflin, Centre Counties), 1818-1826
- Governor John Shulze appointed Huston, Justice, Supreme Court of Pennsylvania, April 17, 1826
