- Studied law with Judge Washington McCartney, November 1846-September 1849

- Admitted to Northampton County Bar, November 1849
- Private Practice with Andrew Reeder, 1851-1864
- Private Practice, 1864-1879
- Governor Henry Hoyt appointed Green, Justice, Supreme Court of Pennsylvania, September 29, 1879
- Elected Justice, Supreme Court of Pennsylvania, November 1880; took office December 2, 1880
- Died in Office, August 16, 1900

- Delegate, Republican Party Convention, 1856
- Delegate at Large, Pennsylvania Constitutional Convention, 1873
- Chairman, Republican County Committee, 1856-1894
- American Bar Association, 1878, one of the founding members
