The 33% below average workload does not result in an unwarranted inequity among the judges due to the geographic positioning of the district. The office is located within a very low crime area and most of the district is very rural with one population center. If the district were to be realigned, the residents of Mercer County would be denied adequate access to the courts due to the distance they would be required to travel to court. This district is a considerable distance from higher caseload districts as well, so absorbing cases would make it difficult for court access by Mercer County residents.
