

The Court of Common Pleas of Clearfield County (46th Judicial District), Clearfield, Pennsylvania is seeking a Judicial Law Clerk for the Judges of the Court of Common Pleas. The position is available in August and applications will be received until the position is filled. The position is generally for a one year period of time from August to August with further extension granted at the discretion of the President Judge. A one year commitment is required. The successful candidate will assist the Judges with legal research, case management and the writing of Opinions and Orders in addition to other traditional Law Clerk duties and assignments. There may be some rotational work with Senior Judges as assigned.

This Judicial Clerkship presents a unique opportunity to observe and be professionally involved with all aspects of the legal system. Clearfield County has two veteran Judges who handle any and all types of civil and criminal cases that come through the Court system, unlike the urban Counties where Judges are assigned to a particular division. If you want to spend a year learning about every aspect of the legal system, this clerkship is for you.

Employment is on a full time basis. Salary is set at a flexible \$46,000.00 plus full County benefits including health care for which there is some contribution from the employee.
