The average caseload and workload for this Judicial District is 16% and 21% greater, respectively, than the State average. This Magisterial District is limited to one municipality which is the central retail location for the County. It would not be feasible nor is anyone (including the MDJ) suggesting the municipality be divided. With approval of the proposed adjustments to courts with lower caseload/workloads, analysis suggests the caseload and workload for this Court will remain in the upper percentage of the Judicial District due to its high concentration of retail business, but it should be closer to the standard range than present.
