A utility knife was also found in the trunk of the vehicle. All three weapons were taken into evidence. Ammunition was seized in addition.

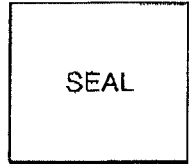

AFFIDAVIT of PROBABLE CAUSE

This affiant is a DuBois Area School District Police Office in Charge (of the School Police.) This affiant has been employed and sworn in for full arrest powers before Judge Fredric Ammerman, Clearfield County Judge Of Common Pleas since December 23, 2013. This affiant previously served 25 years with the Pennsylvania State Police as a Trooper. This officer has 35 years of law enforcement experience. This affiant retired after serving in various capacities including Major Case Investigations, Criminal Investigator, and Criminal Investigation Unit Supervisor at the rank of Corporal.

On 09/19/23, The DuBois Area High School (DAHS,) Principals learned from Teacher Heidi Shindledecker via digital communication at 10:27 hours of two students involved in a verbal confrontation at the dismissal from her English Class on 09/19/23 near approximately 1020 hours. The teacher reported that she didn't hear anything specific, but felt uneasy about the disposition of both students upon leaving her classroom and was worried that a confrontation may occur in the hallway or elsewhere. Mrs. Shindledecker said she was concerned of a physical fight may be brewing. The two students named by Teacher, Mrs. Shindledecker were the defendant Ryan Daniel Mancuso and the victim, Landon John Schrock, both 18 years of age and students of the DuBois Area School District.

Assistant Principal Ms. Lauren McLaughlin and Principal Charles Pasternak attempted to locate both students before their departure from school on 09/19/23, but both students had already left on their usual daily dismissal at 1105 hours. It was decided they would meet with both students the following day to ensure both their safety and the safety of the school and mediate any problems. They would institute a safety plan. Ms. McLaughlin encountered Landon John Schrock, W/N/M-18, DOB 08/21/2005 first at approximately 0740 hours and interviewed him. He provided the following verbal statement. "Ryan Mancuso is crazy. He has threatened me. He has threatened to shoot me and choke me out. He has two weapons in his car. He sometimes has both of these in his car that he drives to school." With that startling statement, she led him to the office for further interview and to meet with Mr. Pasternak.

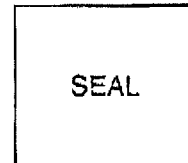

Ms. McLaughlin took Schrock to the office where they also met with Mr. Charles Pasternak, the Principal. Schrock repeated the same statement as above. He then provided a written statement as the following: "I was sitting in English class and Ryan come up to me and started calling me names then said he'd fight me so I said ok than it got separated the he called me after school and was threatening me said he'd shoot me and strangle me and I have seen guns in the back of his car."

In his interview with Mr. Pasternak, Landon Schrock also provided more information that he had received a cell phone call from Ryan Mancuso on his cell phone and a friend accompanying Schrock (at that time) had videoed the phone call. Schrock said that Mancuso wanted to fight him. Schrock said that Mancuso had followed him although Mancuso says that Schrock followed him. Schrock said that is impossible because he was in front of Mancuso's vehicle, not behind. Schrock also said that Mancuso verbally told him that he would shoot him and choke him out during a phone conversation initiated by Mancuso. Schrock said that is on the video and was able to provide that same video of the phone conversation. He provided that video in which a verbal conversation, Schrock identified the caller from his cell phone number and from his voice in which he said was that of Ryan Mancuso. Schrock said they had been friends and that is how he knows of Mancuso's identity, phone number, and voice. Schrock said that he had seen guns in Mancuso's vehicle as late as last week. He thought the guns were a 12 gauge shot gun, camouflage in color, and also a 308 caliber also camouflage in color. He described that Mancuso drives a white Chevrolet Cruz with a Steeler plate on the vehicle.

This affiant met with Schrock and listened to the video recording provided by Schrock at 1125 hours on 09/20/23 in the School Police Conference Room. Schrock shared his cell phone text messages and the video. Schrock presented on his phone the call in topic of Mancuso's incoming call from 814 771 6011 identified by Schrock as a phone number he has known to be for Ryan Mancuso. Schrock also confirmed he knew it was his voice. He said he threatened to shoot him, so his accompanying friend, a juvenile student knows as LH, videoed the phone conversation. This call was incoming at 1131 hours on 09/19/23 and lasted 6 minutes. The following video's audio was heard and confirmed by this affiant of a conversation where a male voice is on the phone with the victim, Schrock. This affiant transcribed it as the following:

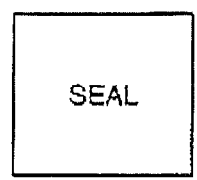

- Inaudible strange in nature fake laugh by the caller
- Schrock questioning the caller, "Dude, you just said you'd shoot, you just said you would shoot me.
- The caller responds, with "uh huh"
- Schrock: You're crazy, you're crazy, You need a gun to take me out? Dude, You're pathetic.
- The caller stated "I will fuckin choke you out with my bare hands.
- Schrock - You'll choke me out?
- The caller responds, Yeah,
- Schrock - Awe that's cute.
- The caller said :Did I stutter?

This call was on 09/19/23 on cell phone (814) 661 0895 (Schrock's cellular telephone) Additionally, Schrock shared text messages from that same number that he again identified was communications with Ryan Mancuso. Mancuso was asking for Schrock to come to his house or meet him elsewhere to fight. Schrock declines that he would go to the house to fight. Schrock also provided these cellular text messages that he identified as communication between Mancuso and he on 09/19/23.

Mr. Charles Pasternak spoke with the Suspect Ryan Mancuso at approximately 0900 hours. Mr. Pasternak advised that he needed to make sure everyone is safe. The Suspect admitted that he had a squirrel gun in the car, and that he also has ammunition. At a later time, Ryan Mancuso said that he may have a second weapon that is a 308 in his vehicle that was parked in the student parking lot but he doesn't remember if that is in the vehicle or not.

Ryan Mancuso made the following written statement for Mr. Pasternak: "This all started because Landon was told I was hanging out with his ex-girlfriend. He then followed me from b-line Sheetz all the way to the Tannery. After he stopped following me he called me and accused me of all that and threatened to fight me so I said the same thing to him. Then yesterday he started telling people I followed him so I confronted him

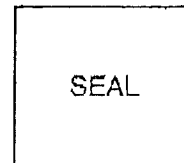

in Mrs. Shingledecker's class and he stood up over me and threatened to curbstomp me. Then after that we left school and he waited in the parking lot for me to come out to jump me. That's when I called him and made my threat.

During a Threat Assessment with DAHS Counselor David Volpe received verbal and written statements from Mancuso that indicated that Schrock had been following him. He admitted of the verbal confrontation in English class. He also said he had called Schrock after their school departure "yesterday," and threatened to fight him and that he threated Schrock that "he would shoot him." Mancuso added that he knew he shouldn't have said that.

Ryan Mancuso operated a white in color Chevrolet Cruz, owned by his mother Jill Mancuso, bearing PA Registration LWZ9617 into the DAHS student parking lot for school arrival on 09/20/23. Ownership of that vehicle was confirmed through a records check NCIC of JNET through Clearfield County Control to be of his mother, Jill Mancuso of the same address.

Officer Michael Britton of the DASD's School Police secured the vehicle and saw a possible a caliber 22 weapon in the vehicle with a box of ammunition on School Property on 09/20/23 at 0945 hours. This is in violation of PA 912 Possession of Weapons on School Property.

School traffic and classes were held inside in a different manner, while the defendant was taken into custody, not to put anyone else in danger. Staff members held hallways clear and diverted student travel not to come towards this incident. School Police Officers were sent to the High School to assist and one officer took custody of the vehicle in the parking lot to remain chain of custody. Officer Michael Britton diverted his duties to other officers while he was assigned at the DuBois City Building where the defendant was transported. Officer Britton provided prisoner checks and also completed the inventory search along with this affiant once the Search Warrant was obtained under approval of the ADA Brittany McCracken SW205-2023.

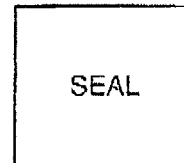




