¹ Objector's argument at the hearing on this date was that the Candidate Declaration and the Candidate Affidavit must match in terms of geography. That is, Objector argued that Candidate had to execute his Candidate Declaration within the legislative district which is associated with the Candidate Affidavit. None of the authorities cited by Objector supported his arguments. The Court is not aware of any legal support for this argument. The Court deems these arguments frivolous, lacking any legal support whatsoever. These arguments do not suggest a reasonable basis for the extension of existing law. Candidate did not seek costs against Objector.
