Crawford County District Court Administrator Elected as President for the Pennsylvania Association of Court Management

HARRISBURG—At a recent meeting of the Pennsylvania Association of Court Management, Crawford County District Court Administrator Heidi Shiderly was installed as president of the statewide organization.

Shiderly was sworn in by Crawford County President Judge John F. Spataro. She will serve as president through May 2025, while continuing her service as district court administrator for Crawford County, a position she has held for eight years.

“I am humbled to be elected to this position,” Shiderly said. “It is such an honor to be recognized by my peers and colleagues throughout the state.”

Shiderly shared that she hopes to develop new ways to educate fellow court managers and administrators, improve job performance and hold meaningful conferences.

“The main focus of this association is education and a central theme this year will be looking at how we, as court managers, can be ‘all in’ as leaders.”

Shiderly was a law clerk in Crawford County for 12 years, serving President Judges Gordon R. Miller and Anthony J. Vadaro, before becoming the first deputy court administrator in October of 2010 and then district court administrator in March 2016.

Established in 1989, the Pennsylvania Association of Court Management, a nonprofit, assists in providing education and training to advance and promote professionalism in the Pennsylvania Courts, creating opportunities for members to learn and grow as court professionals.
