AND NOW, this & day of November, 2024, the Court having received a telephone call from William R. Bunt, Esq. at approximately 7:18 p.m. that a bomb threat had been received by the Perry County Board of Elections and that as a result thereof, said Board's headquarters in the Freedom Building located in New Blomfield had to be vacated and the Court having had further communications with Attorney Bunt as the evening progressed regarding said bomb threat and that it was the request of the Perry County Board of Elections to postpone the canvassing of the mail-in and absentee ballots until 10:00 a.m. on November 6, 2024 due to said Election Board's inability to start the canvassing process as originally planned and further due to the fact that said bomb threat caused said Election Board to have to change their plans for the processing of precinct results thereby necessitating that personnel originally assigned to the canvassing process were needed to provide assistance elsewhere; the Court hereby Orders that the canvassing of mail-in and absentee ballots be postponed from 8:00 p.m. November 5, 2024 until 10:00 a.m. November 6, 2024, as the building had not been cleared and deemed safe for occupancy by the Pennsylvania State Police as of the time of the Perry County Board of Elections' request for postponement.
