PETITION FROM THE NOVEMBER 5, 2024 GENERAL ELECTION AS MAY BE STATISTICALLY RECOUNTED BY THE CENTRE COUNTY ELECTIONS ON NOVEMBER 14, 2024

Petitioners, Michelle M. Schellberg, et al, by and through their undersigned counsel, files the within Petition from the November 5, 2024 general election as may be statistically recounted by the Centre County Board of Elections on November 14, 2024, in which the Centre County Board of Elections may knowingly statistically recount the vote count despite having improperly and under violation of Pennsylvania law excluded all votes except in person ballots under Pennsylvania law 25 P.S. §3031.17, Exhibit 1. In addition the Centre County Election Board has given no indication it tends to comply with the State law in future elections.

- Petitioner Michelle M. Schellberg, a Centre County registered voter who resides at 250 Genesis Drive, Port Matilda, PA 16870, is a qualified elector in Centre County.
- Additional Petitioner's names and addresses are attached and made part by this
 reference. Each of the named Petitioners are Centre County registered voters qualified as
 electors in Centre County.

- 3. On November 5, 2024, the general election was held in Centre County.
- 4. On Friday, November 8, 2024, the Centre County Election Board, contrary to Pennsylvania law, advised over the objection of the Petitioner the required statistically recount to be conducted on Thursday, November 14, 2024, would include only in person ballots in direct contravention of the Pennsylvania Statute which requires all ballots to be included in the random sample.
- Respondent is aware of the Pennsylvania Statute, 20 P.S. §3031.17 which is attached as Exhibit 1 and made part by this reference.
- 6. 25 PA. STAT. Section 3031.5, the Secretary of the Commonwealth)b_ requirements provides certain voting systems, including the system used by Centre County requires they must also comply with the Secretary of the Commonwealth's requirements report.
- 7. The Secretary of the Commonwealth report issued on January 13, 2023 (cover age and page 26 attached) requires the voting system used by Centre County (DS 6300) to conduct statistical recoounts to be done by a random sample of ballots after each election exclusively by manual recount of the voter marked paper ballots.
- 8. By statistically recounting only in person ballots, the Respondent is disenfranchising all (over 20% of the votes in this election) who voted by mail in ballots.
- 9. Respondents were advised in person of their error by the Petitioners at the Respondent's meeting on Friday, November 8, 2024 at which time the Petitioner advised the Respondent to include all ballots as set forth in the Pennsylvania Code in the statistically recount.

10. Respondent has indicated they will continue to mistakenly violate Pennsylvania law in this and future elections by statistically recounting only in person ballots despite mail in ballots comprising over 20% of the ballots.

11. If allowed to continue, the unlawful actions of the Respondent will deprive future lawful mail in Pennsylvania voters from having their vote count and be properly statistically recounted.

WHEREFORE, Petitioners respectfully request this Honorable Court enter an Order granting the Petitioners' Petition and the Respondent include all ballots in the random 2024 statistically recount and in future elections in conformance with 25 P.S. §3031.17 and manually recount paper ballots in accordance with the Secretary of the Commonwealth report issued January 13, 2023.

§ 3031.17. Statistical sample

The county board of elections, as part of the computation and canvass of returns, shall conduct a statistical recount of a random sample of ballots after each election using manual, mechanical or electronic devices of a type different than those used for the specific election. The sample shall include at least two (2) per centum of the votes cast or two thousand (2,000) votes whichever is the lesser.

- voting be preserved (see Pa. Const Art. VII § 4; and Section 1107-A(I) of the Election Code, 25 P.S. § 3031.7(1)).
- B. No components of the EVS 6300 shall be connected to any modem or network interface, including the Internet, at any time. A standalone local area wired network configuration may be considered, in which all connected devices are certified voting system components. Transmission of unofficial results can be accomplished by writing results to media and moving the media to a different computer that may be connected to a network. Any wireless access points in the district components of EVS 6300, including wireless LAN cards or network adapters, must be uninstalled or disabled prior to shipping to a county board of elections.
- C. Regional Results, included in the EAC certified components of EVS6300 is not certified for use in Pennsylvania.
- D. Because EVS 6300 is a paper-based system, counties using the EVS 6300 must comply at a minimum with Section 1117-A of the Election Code, 25 P.S. § 3031.17, that requires a "statistical recount of a random sample of ballots after each election using manual, mechanical or electronic devices of a type different than those used for the specific election." This audit must be conducted exclusively via a manual count of the voter marked paper ballots. Counties must include in the sample ballots such samples as may be marked by ADA compliant components. Counties are advised to consult the Directive Concerning the Use, Implementation and Operations of Electronic Voting Systems by the County Boards of Elections issued by the Secretary of the Commonwealth on June 9, 2011, any subsequent revisions of that Directive, and any other directives that may apply to audits of electronic voting systems.
- E. All jurisdictions implementing the EVS 6300 need to carry out a full Logic and Accuracy test on each device without fail and maintain evidence of Logic
