MOTION TO DISMISS APPEAL AS MOOT

AND NOW comes the Montgomery County Board of Elections (the "County"), by its attorneys, John A. Marlatt, Assistant Solicitor and Joshua Wertheimer, Assistant Solicitor, and moves to dismiss this appeal as moot, averring as follows:

- 1. On November 14, 2024, the Montgomery County Board of Elections voted in an open meeting to include 501 undated and misdated mail-in and absentee ballots in the count of the 2024 General Election.
- 2. The David McCormick Campaign, the Republican National Committee, and the Republican Party of Pennsylvania timely filed an appeal of the decision with this Court.
- 3. On November 18, 2024, the Pennsylvania Supreme Court issued an Order that all County Boards of Elections shall not count undated and misdated absentee and

mail-in ballots in the November 5, 2024 General Election. See Supreme Court Order (Exhibit A).

4. Pursuant to the attached November 18, 2024 order from the Pennsylvania Supreme Court, the Montgomery County Board of Elections has removed all misdated and undated mail-in and absentee ballots from the unofficial tally of the 2024 General Election, and will not include those ballots as part of the official results certified to the Secretary of the Commonwealth, thereby rendering this appeal moot.

WHEREFORE, the Montgomery County Board of Elections moves to have this appeal be dismissed as moot.
