It is hereby ORDERED, DIRECTED, and DECREED that:

1. Attorney Dickey has expressed his desire to file pre-trial motions in advance of the Preliminary Call of the List. Said pre-trial motions shall be filed on or before the end of business on February 21, 2025, with courtesy copies provided to Chambers and to the DA's Office upon filing with the Clerk of Court.
