Pennsylvania Supreme Court to Hold Oral Argument Session in Philadelphia

HARRISBURG- The Supreme Court of Pennsylvania will hold oral argument sessions on Tues., March 4 and Wed., March 5, in the Supreme Court courtroom in City Hall.

Attendees should be aware that cases or other events in the building may attract large crowds and should consider possible delays. Seating in the courtroom is available on a first-come-first served basis.

As a reminder, the use of any electronic or recording devices, including cell phones, cameras, laptops and smart watches, is prohibited inside the courtroom.

As the highest Court in the commonwealth and the oldest appellate court in the nation, the Pennsylvania Supreme Court is the definitive interpreter of Pennsylvania's Constitution and laws. The Court has full administrative authority over all aspects of Pennsylvania's judicial system and may also hear cases involving issues of immediate public importance arising in any court in the commonwealth.
