COMMONWEALTH'S MOTION FOR INDIVIDUAL VOIR DIRE

AND NOW, comes the Commonwealth, by and through the Office of the District Attorney of Lebanon County, in support of its Motion for Individual Voir Dire in the above-captioned case:

- (1) On March 8, 2023, the Fort Indiantown Police Department charged the Defendant with a Felony Violation of the Wiretap Act and Misdemeanor False Reports.
- (2) Specifically, it is alleged the Defendant secretly and surreptitiously recorded consensual sexual acts with the victim. It is further alleged the Defendant made the false police report of 'rape' against the victim to justify recording the victim without his knowledge.
- Ouring the pendency of the case, the Defendant gave interviews to various media sources. Additional media sources covered her case and touted she is a 'rape victim' charged with filming her attacker. Various social media sites contain statements and postings about the case and the Defendant's claim of being a 'rape victim.'
- (4) The media coverage continues to this day. The coverage spans six (6) months in length thus far. The coverage includes social media, tv news, and print news.

- (5) The Commonwealth possesses grave concern as to the preservation of the jury's objectivity and potential for taint within the jury pool on the day of voir dire.
- (6) The Commonwealth possesses additional concerns that questioning the jury *en masse* would leave the potential for one juror's answers to affect the rest of the panel.
- (7) Pursuant to Pa.R.Crim.P. 631 (E)(1)(a) 'Impaneling Jury' (2010), the Commonwealth thus requests individual voir dire examination and selection.
- (8) The Commonwealth further requests This Honorable Court follow the procedures used in the *Commonwealth v. Kim Maurer* trial a high publicity homicide. In that trial, the Court utilized individual voir dire. Prior to the commencement of voir dire, the Court also sent a supplemental list of juror questions to every potential juror along with the standard issued juror questionnaire. Jurors completed both documents and returned them to Court Administration. Both parties then reviewed the juror responses to the standard and supplemental questionnaire. Both parties then told the Court if they had an objection to any juror reporting for jury service on the day of selection. The Court made the ultimate ruling whether any juror was pre-disqualified. Court Administration relieved those disqualified jurors. The remaining jurors reported in typical fashion for individual voir dire.
- (9) The Commonwealth is requesting that both Defense and Commonwealth have proposed questions to the Court by April 2, 2025. The Commonwealth is requesting that the Court and Counsel have a status conference to discuss the proposed questions, and that a completed questionnaire be sent to the potential jurors by April 15, 2025.

WHEREFORE, the Commonwealth respectfully requests that This Honorable Court issue an Order which grants its Motion.
