It is hereby ORDERED, DIRECTED, and DECREED that:

- 1. The Commonwealth has represented its intention to proceed with a Writ of Habeas Corpus Ad Prosequendum. It is anticipated that said writ will be filed with the federal court, by and through the Blair County District Attorney's office, forthwith.
- The Commonwealth remains under an ongoing obligation to file a notice every sixty (60) days relative to the Defendant's ability to personally appear in the Blair County Court of Common Pleas for proceedings in light of him being in federal custody.

3. The Court also reiterates that either party may file a preacipe upon a change of circumstances, requesting the Court schedule a proceeding.
