Pennsylvania Supreme Court to Hold Oral Argument Session in Pittsburgh

HARRISBURG- The Supreme Court of Pennsylvania will hold oral argument sessions on Tues., Oct. 7, and Wed., Oct. 8 in the Supreme Court courtroom in the City-County Building, beginning at 9:30 a.m. each day.

The Court has full administrative authority over all aspects of Pennsylvania's judicial system and may also hear cases involving issues of immediate public importance arising in any court in the commonwealth.
