Pennsylvania Supreme Court to Hold Oral Argument Session in Harrisburg

HARRISBURG- The Supreme Court of Pennsylvania will hold oral argument sessions on Tues., May 19 and Wed., May 20 in the Supreme Court courtroom in the Capitol building in Harrisburg, beginning at 9:30 a.m. each day.

Seating in the courtroom is available on a first-come-first served basis.

The Court has full administrative authority over all aspects of Pennsylvania's judicial system and may also hear cases involving issues of immediate public importance arising in any court in the commonwealth.
