PETITION FOR RELIEF

AND NOW, this 14th day of August, 2017, comes the Judicial Conduct Board of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania (Board) by the undersigned counsel and files this Petition for Relief.

- On or about July 5, 2017, the Board filed a Board Complaint against Judicial Officer, Michael R. Muth, in the above captioned matter.
- 2. Pursuant to Rule 401(E) of the Court of Judicial Discipline Rules of Procedure (C.J.D.R.P.), by correspondence dated July 5, 2017, the Board provided the Judicial Officer with exculpatory evidence relevant to the charges contained in the Complaint.
- 3. Pursuant to Rule 401(A) and (D) of the C.J.D.R.P., by correspondence dated July 24, 2017, the Board provided the Judicial Officer with discoverable evidence relevant to the charges contained in the Complaint.
- 4. On or about August 2, 2017, the Judicial Officer filed an Answer and New Matter of MDJ Michael R. Muth to Judicial Conduct Board's Complaint.
- 5. The Answer consisted of 88 consecutively numbered paragraphs.

- 6. The New Matter consisted of 18 consecutively numbered paragraphs.
- 7. Pursuant to Rule 411(A) of the C.J.D.R.P., the Judicial Officer may file an omnibus motion in the following manner:

All motions, challenges, and applications or requests for an order or relief on behalf of the Judicial Officer shall be consolidated in one written motion, except as otherwise provided in these rules, or as permitted by the Conference Judge. The omnibus motion shall be filed no later than 30 days of the service of the Board Complaint.

- 8. The Judicial Officer has not filed an omnibus motion as permitted by Rule 411(A).
- 9. Pursuant to Rule 413 of the C.J.D.R.P., the Judicial Officer may file an answer in the following manner:

Within 30 days after the service of a Board Complaint, if no omnibus motion is filed, or within 20 days after the dismissal of all or part of the omnibus motion, the Judicial Officer may file an answer admitting or denying the allegations contained in the Board Complaint. Failure to file an answer shall be deemed a denial of all factual allegations contained in the Board Complaint. Unless otherwise ordered by the Court, no additional pleading will be accepted.

- 10. The C.J.D.R.P. do not provide for the pleading of New Matter such as that filed by the Judicial Officer on August 2, 2017.
- 11. The C.J.D.R.P. do not provide a mechanism for the Board to respond to New Matter filed by the Judicial Officer.

WHEREFORE, the Board, by and through Melissa L. Norton, Assistant Counsel, respectfully requests that this Honorable Court strike the New Matter filed by the Judicial Officer on August 2, 2017, as it is not a permissible or recognized pleading pursuant to the C.J.D.R.P. In the alternative, the Board respectfully requests that this Honorable Court defer resolution of the matter raised in the within Petition for Relief until the Pre-Trial Conference provided for by Rule 421 of the C.J.D.R.P.
