RESIGNATION UNDER Pa.R.D.E. 215

Yale Darran Weinstein hereby tenders his unconditional resignation from the practice of law in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in conformity with Pa.R.D.E. 215 ("Enforcement Rules") and further states as follows:

- 1. He is a formerly admitted attorney in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, having been admitted to the bar on November 12, 2002. His attorney registration number is 89678.
- 2. By Order dated July 14, 2023, the Supreme Court of Pennsylvania placed him on temporary suspension effective immediately.
- 3. On August 22, 2023, he filed with the Disciplinary Board a verified statement of compliance pursuant to Pa.R.D.E. 217(e)(1).
 - 4. He desires to submit his resignation as a member of said bar.

- 5. His resignation is freely and voluntarily rendered; he is not being subjected to coercion or duress and he is fully aware of the implications of submitting this resignation.
- 6. He acknowledges that he is fully aware of his right to consult and employ counsel to represent him in the instant proceeding. He has retained, consulted with and acted upon the advice of counsel in connection with his decision to execute the within resignation.
- 7. He is aware that there is presently pending an investigation into allegations that he has been guilty of misconduct the nature of which allegations were referred to in the Joint Petition for Emergency Temporary Suspension pursuant to Pa.R.D.E. 208(f), he and the Office of Disciplinary Counsel ("ODC") submitted to this Honorable Court on June 29, 2023. A true and correct copy of the Joint Petition is attached as **Exhibit A**.
- 8. He is aware that West Goshen law enforcement is currently investigating his criminal misconduct for financial improprieties relating to his former law firm's Interest on Lawyer's Trust Accounts ("IOLTAs"), which he self-reported to ODC in 2023.
- 9. He has and will cooperate with the criminal investigation and will surrender himself to law enforcement or the Court of Common Pleas when charged.

- 10. He submits the within resignation because he knows that he could not successfully defend himself against the charges of professional misconduct relative to the improprieties he acknowledges regarding the IOLTA account of his former law firm.
- 11. He is fully aware that the submission of this Resignation Statement is irrevocable and that he can only apply for reinstatement to the practice of law pursuant to the provisions of Enforcement Rule 218(b) and (c).
- 12. He is aware that pursuant to Enforcement Rule 215(c) the fact that he has tendered his resignation shall become a matter of public record immediately upon delivery of the resignation statement to Disciplinary Counsel or the Board Prothonotary.
- 13. Upon entry of the order disbarring him on consent, to the extent necessary, he will promptly comply with the notice, withdrawal, resignation, trust account, and cease-and-desist provisions of Enforcement Rule 217 (a), (b), (c) and (d).
- 14. After entry of the order disbarring him on consent, he will file a verified statement of compliance or a supplemental verified statement as required by Enforcement Rule 217(e)(1).
 - 15. He is aware that the waiting period for eligibility to apply for

reinstatement to the practice of law under Enforcement Rule 218(b) shall not begin until he files the supplemental verified statement of compliance required by Enforcement Rule 217(e)(1) containing the information and documentation not applicable at the time of the statement filed by him on August 22, 2023, or all of the information and documentation required by subdivision (e) (1) if he has failed to file the initial statement and if the order of disbarment contains a provision that makes the disbarment retroactive to an earlier date, then the waiting period will be deemed to have begun on that earlier date.

- 16. He requests that the Order of disbarment contain a provision that makes disbarment retroactive to the date of his temporary suspension.
- 17. He understands the decision whether to grant his request for retroactivity is within the Court's discretion.

It is understood that the statements made herein are subject to the penalties of 18 Pa.C.S., Section 4904 (relating to unsworn falsification to authorities).

JOINT PETITION FOR EMERGENCY TEMPORARY SUSPENSION PURSUANT TO Pa.R.D.E. 208(f)

TO THE HONORABLE CHIEF JUSTICE AND JUSTICES OF THE SUPREME COURT OF PENNSYLVANIA:

Petitioner, the Office of Disciplinary Counsel ("ODC"), by Thomas J. Farrell, Esquire, Chief Disciplinary Counsel, and Marie C. Dooley, Esquire, Disciplinary Counsel, and Respondent, Yale Darran Weinstein, Esquire ("Respondent"), by Robert A. Burke, Esquire and Peter E. Kratsa, Esquire (collectively, "Respondent's Counsel"), jointly file this Petition for Emergency Temporary Suspension pursuant to Pennsylvania Rule of Disciplinary Enforcement ("Pa.R.D.E.") 208(f), and state:

1. Pursuant to Pa.R.D.E. 207, ODC, whose principal office is located at Office of Chief Disciplinary Counsel, Pennsylvania Judicial Center, 601 Commonwealth Avenue, Suite 2700, P.O. Box 62485,

Harrisburg, Pennsylvania, 17106, is invested with the power and duty to investigate all matters involving alleged misconduct of an attorney admitted to practice law in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and to prosecute all disciplinary proceedings brought in accordance with the provisions of the Enforcement Rules.

- 2. Respondent was born April 23, 1972 and was admitted to the Bar of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania on November 12, 2002.
- 3. Respondent is subject to the disciplinary jurisdiction of the Disciplinary Board of the Supreme Court of Pennsylvania.
 - 4. Respondent is on active status in Pennsylvania.
- 5. Respondent is the sole equity owner of his firm Burton Neil & Associates PC located at 1060 Andrew Drive, Suite 170, West Chester, PA 19380-5600.
- 6. On June 21, 2023, ODC opened File No. C2-23-566 against Respondent based on a letter submitted on his behalf by his attorneys wherein Respondent "acknowledge[d] improprieties regarding the IOLTA account for his law firm, Burton Neil & Associates" and communicated "his cooperation in an anticipated Disciplinary Board investigation."

- 7. Respondent is currently under criminal investigation by the West Goshen Police Department for financial improprieties relating to his IOLTA account.
- 8. Respondent's self-report of IOLTA irregularities, as set forth herein, warrants seeking relief pursuant to either Pa.R.D.E. 208(f)(1) or Pa.R.D.E. 208(f)(5).
 - 9. Respondent has no record of discipline.
- 10. Respondent has agreed to the issuance of an Order for his temporary suspension.
- 11. Respondent agrees to provide ODC RPC 1.15(c) Records pursuant to Pa.R.D.E. 221(g)(2) and Disciplinary Board Rules § 87.7(e).
- 12. Respondent acknowledges that his request to be placed on temporary suspension is made knowingly, intelligently, and voluntarily. To the extent applicable, Respondent waives the rule to show cause and other procedural provisions set forth in Pa.R.D.E. 208(f)(1) and Pa.R.D.E. 208(f)(5).
- 13. Respondent has had an opportunity to consult with Respondent's Counsel in connection with his decision to execute this Joint Petition.

- 14.
