- Maintain all required books and records required by Rule of Professional Conduct 1.15, and make them accessible for review by Office of Disciplinary Counsel within 20 days of a request without the necessity for issuance of a subpoena, see Rule 1.15(c); and,

3. Provide with the quarterly reports to Office of Disciplinary Counsel a copy of the check ledgers for each Trust Account and for any other account in which you held Fiduciary Funds pursuant to 1.15(I), the monthly reconciliations for such accounts, and your individual client ledgers for that quarter.

Failure to abide with the terms of the Probation shall be grounds for further action pursuant to Enforcement Rule 208(h). Costs shall be paid by the Respondent.
